He showed photos of the cabin reservation work and explained how the work was done and who did the work. He informed us that the City of Beverly in 2001 told the RCHS that the partially assembled log cabin had to be removed from their property due to safety concerns. Cliff was the Building Inspector for Beverly at the time. None of the Stalnaker leadership were informed of this important fact. He informed that the chinking is made with wire mesh and a form of concrete instead of the historical correct horsehair and mud. After over twenty years we finally got to meet the man that did this amazing work on our cabin. We honored him with a framed, signed and number drawing of the Stalnaker Cabin by Brad Stalnaker of Morgantown, WV.

A note from the Treasurer- Dan Wilson

The tax-exempt status of 501(c)(3) has had a positive impact on the generous donations from the Stalnaker cousins to the Society. According to the tax account/lawyer the lifetime membership dues are not tax deductible because you receive the annual Welcome Letter, annual membership card plus the newsletter and holiday card with the annual brag book.

Annual Dues are used to support the History Day, Annual Meeting & Reunion and for the publishing and mailing of the newsletters and Holiday Cards.

Generous donations are used for the maintenance of the cabin and cemetery.

We have established a permanent improvement fund (Earl and Erma Stalnaker Memorial Fund).

We have had several relatives passed this year and the immediate relatives sent in monies in their memory.

The necessary tax forms have been filed with the State of WV (in August each year) and Federal Government (in January each year). The cemetery property taxes were paid.

All bills are paid after approval by the President using the approved budget.

We have spent \$10,000 legal fees to save the cabin.

A note from the Jacob Stalnaker Cabin Manager & Negotiator -VP Robert Stalnaker

At this time no one can assess our cabin due to the ongoing mediation.

However, during the court disclosures from RCHS for court, we have learned that RCHS has been using the cabin and removed two chairs for safety reasons.

What are the safety issues that apply to RCHS items and not SFA items?

We had requested to remove our items from our cabin but were told we cannot remove any items from the cabin while we are in mediation (lawsuit).

RCHS took \$195 from our donation basket and plus another \$24 from our donation basket. They put the monies from the tours that our cabin manager, Darrell Allman conducted with our Stalnaker relatives in RCHS account.

Darrell drove from Weston to Beverly to give these tours at his expense.

RCHS gave a July 3, 2022, cabin tour to 35 Stalnaker descendants that <u>did not sign</u> in the registry book as required for any visitors to our cabin. Why?

RCHS records the temperature and humidity of our cabin without our permission.

We are unclear as to why this is necessary. It was never discussed with us.

We have the monthly pest control done and keep the insurance paid during the lawsuit.

The roof continues to leak but we are unable to repair it due to legal matters. The new roof will cost \$30,000. RCHS claims that all items in the cabin were given to RCHS.

Our major donors have already sent letters to our attorney stating the items were never given to RCHS.

In March 2023 where I represented our society with honor. The Judge determined that we have been an organization for more than 5 years and have maintained our cabin; therefore, he has set a court date for January 2024. The Judge wants real mediation to occur between the two nonprofit organizations prior to the court date. We have provided our list of relatives that have knowledge of our cabin being given to us and not RCHS for our side of the lawsuit. If you have pertinent knowledge of our cabin for the lawsuit, please contact us at wilsondan@aol.com so we get your information to our attorney.

Our goal is to clarify that we own the cabin.

We want to be able to manage it independently and would like to purchase the land where our cabin is located.

Pray that we can keep our cabin.
